

## INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB) – OPEN NATIONAL BIDDING

The District Council of Black River is pleased to invite bids from qualified and eligible bidders for the Procurement of Services for Street Cleaning, Refuse Collection and Disposal including carting away of post-cyclonic waste in the District Council of Black River for Lot 1 and 2 for a period of thirty-six (36) months as per requirement contained in the Bidding document. Participation is limited to Citizens of Mauritius, or entities incorporated in Mauritius. Joint ventures should be among entities incorporated in Mauritius.

Bidders shall be registered with the Ministry of Local Government and Disaster Risk Management as Scavenging Contractor. The procurement is being conducted through Open National Bidding procedures according to the provisions of the Mauritius Public Procurement Act 2006 as amended.

Bids must be submitted online on the e-Procurement System on Tuesday 27 July 2021 up to 13.30 hours (Mauritian Time) at latest.

Bidders who have submitted bids online by the closing date and time shall decrypt and re-encrypt their bids on Tuesday 27 July 2021 as from 14.31 hours (Mauritian Time) till Thursday 29 July 2021 at 14.00 hours (Mauritian Time)

Bids shall be opened online on the e-Procurement system on Thursday 29 July 2021 as from 14.01 hours (Mauritian Time) up to 18.00 hours (Mauritian Time) in the Conference Room of the Central Procurement Board in the presence of the Bidder/Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address mentioned above.
