3. Closing date for submission of expression of interest is **Monday 01 December 2025 by 15h30 at latest**
4. Forms received after the closing date and time will not be considered.
5. The Council does not bind itself to accept the highest or any bid nor will it assign any reason whatsoever for the rejection of any bid.

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Scope of Works

The Regular Emptying of Eco-bins fixed by the District Council of Black River and Transportation of the Recyclables to the Appropriate Waste Disposal Facility

The District Council of Black River has fixed 37 eco-bins within the villages under its jurisdiction as per the attached list for the collection of PET Bottles and other recyclables

The Council is inviting for Expression of Interests from companies involved in collection and/or in the processing of recyclables to submit their proposals for the regular emptying of the eco-bins and transportation to the recycling companies.

The selected service provider will be called upon to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the Council and their services will consist of the followings:

1. To collect PET bottles, plastic products and other recyclables from the Eco-bins fixed by the Council and any other bin to be fixed in the future by the Council or any other authority or organisation as will be communicated to the service provider.
2. The Eco-bins shall be emptied on a regular basis or upon instruction from an authorised officer of the Council.
3. To keep the bins under lock and to keep the keys safely. The bins shall be opened upon request from an authorised officer of the Council for inspection or any other purpose.
4. No other person or authority shall have access to the bins unless directed otherwise by an authorised officer of the Council.
5. All recyclables removed from the bins shall be reused and/or disposed of at an approved recycling plant or as directed by the Council.
6. To carry out regularly and as and when necessary minor maintenance works to the bins (e.g. painting and minor repairs to the doors, openings, and metal grids, etc.). For the purpose of service, “minor maintenance” means any repair or maintenance work costing less than Rs 500.00 per eco-bin.
7. To affix informative and instructive stickers relevant to collection of recyclables on the eco-bins.
8. The eco-bins and their surroundings shall be regularly cleaned. Any organic and non-recyclable wastes disposed of in the bin and its vicinities shall be removed.
9. Creepers and other invasive plants on and near the bins should be regularly removed.
10. To inform the Council whenever any bin requires major repairs. The bin shall be inspected by an officer of the Public Infrastructure Department of the Council and if it is found that repairs are not consequent, the Council shall refer the matter back

to the Service Provider for repairs and the Service Provider shall abide by the instruction given to it.

11. Major repairs and maintenance works costing more than Rs 500.00 per eco-bin will be carried out by the Council.
12. In case any bin is in a deteriorated state, the Council may cause same to be removed and the service provider shall be informed accordingly.
13. Any act of vandalism or theft on the bins shall be reported to the Police and the Council.
14. The bins shall not be used for any other purpose without the approval of the Council.
15. To carry out regular campaigns to sensitize members of the public and/or inhabitants of the Council's area on the importance of recycling or on any other environmental issues. Reports on the campaigns carried out should be submitted to the Council as and when required and upon request.
16. The Service Provider may, with the collaboration of the Council or any other organisation or Ministry, organise cleaning and embellishment campaigns and implement green environmental projects within the Council's area. Such projects may include but not limited to the fixing of additional bins.
17. The Service Provider shall participate actively in cleaning and embellishment campaigns organised by the Council, the National Environment Cleaning Authority or any other authority within the Council's area.
18. To submit to the Council on a monthly basis a report on the volume and/or weight of each type of recyclable removed from the eco-bins and activities related to the MOU carried out during the month.
19. To submit to the Council any additional information being requested by an authorised officer within the delay given.
20. The bidder shall propose a monthly fee to be paid to the council for each kilogram of PET bottles and other recyclables being collected from the eco-bins in the required form.
21. In the event, the Council implements a project for source segregation of wastes in a particular village or region, the service provider shall collect recyclables (house to house) from the appropriate bins from each household in that village or region.
