RULES FOR THE RENTAL OF FOOTBALL GROUNDS

CONDITIONS:-

- 1. Rental of football grounds is restricted to registered organisations, registered cultural groups and sporting clubs for the organisation of social and sports activities, exhibitions, trade fairs, cultural shows, fancy fairs etc.
- 2. Fees for the use of football grounds are payable as follows:

(i)	Deposit
(::)	Dent of foodball and a

(ii) Rent of football ground

- Rs 1,000 per day
- Rs 1,000 minimum per dayRs 500
- (iii) Cleaning of football ground(iv) Overtime Allowances payable to attendants
- At approved rates

(v) Electricity Charges

- Rs 8.00 per unit consumed for night events on lighted football grounds
- 3. Use of football grounds by football clubs for football playing is free of charge except for night playing on lighted football grounds where electricity charges are payable at the rate of Rs. 8.00 per unit consumed
- 4. Affixing of posters should be effected on panels to be provided by applicant to that effect.
- 5. <u>No use of alcoholic drinks</u> is allowed inside the premises of football grounds.
- 6. Football grounds should be vacated <u>at latest by 10.00 p.m.</u>
- 7. Acts of vandalism/damages inside the football grounds will be the sole responsibility of applicant who will have to make good at his/her own costs.
- 8. The deposit effected will be forfeited in case of damages and applicant should refund the monetary cost of any damage exceeding the deposit.
- 9. Applicant should ensure that members of the public do not indulge in immoral acts inside the premises of football grounds.
- 10. Offensive weapons and the use of drugs are prohibited inside the premises of the football grounds.
- 11. Village Councils <u>will not be held responsible</u> for any injury/accident sustained by applicant or any member of the public inside the premises of the football grounds.
- 12. Village Councils <u>will not be liable</u> for damages to sound equipment due to voltage fluctuation and for any damages to other furniture and equipment belonging to applicant.
- 13. Arrangements for police assistance should be made by applicant as and when directed by the council.
- 14. Arrangements for electricity supply for night events on unlighted football grounds should be made by applicant.
